All plant heights are measured from the top of the pot and represent the exact height when planted. Pictures shown are up to date and a true representation of the plants you will receive.

With its glossy leaves and impressive growth rate of up to 3 feet per year, this evergreen shrub is an ideal candidate for quickly establishing dense, attractive hedges that provide both privacy and visual appeal. Its vigorous growth and glossy foliage make it a sought-after choice for landscaping projects where fast hedging results are required.

- Planting: Suitable for normal to clay soils, doesn't like chalky soil.
- Position: full sun to full shade
- Growth Rate: Fast growing, expect up to 90cm (3ft) per year
- Height: Easily maintained at: 1-5m can grow up to 8m if left untrimmed
- Maintenance: Trimmed once or twice a year
- Soil drainage: Moist but well drained
- Flowering: Yes
- Berries: Yes

PORTUGUESE LAUREL HEDGE



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Portuguese Laurel has beautiful glossy green leaves that are spearhead shaped with a lightly serrated edge. The new growth has a deep crimson red colour and overall these bushes are most attractive. Portuguese Laurel has hugely grown in popularity due to it's density of foliage and its relatively fast growth. These plants provide a fabulous evergreen screen and give instant privacy.

- Planting: Suitable for normal, clay or chalk soils, full sun to full shade and inland or exposed sites
- Growth Rate: Average growing - Expect up to 60cm (2ft) per year
- Height: Easily maintained at: 1-5m
- Maintenance: Trimmed once or twice a year
- Soil drainage:Moist but well drained
- Flowering - Yes
- Berries - Yes

GRISELINIA

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Griselinia, also dubbed the New Zealand Broadleaf, presents a dense evergreen hedge characterised by soft, glossy, apple green leaves on pear green stems. It thrives in well-drained soil and full sun, requiring minimal pruning, primarily for branch tidying. Griselinia serves as an ideal windbreak in coastal regions and is commonly employed in areas accessible to livestock and animals due to its non-toxic nature.

- Planting: Suitable for normal, chalk and clay soils, full sun to semi shaded areas and inland, exposed and coastal sites
- Growth Rate: Average growing, expect up to 60cm a year
- Height: Easily maintained at 1-6m
- Maintenance: Trimmed once a year
- Soil drainage:Moist but well drained
- Flowering - Yes
- Berries - Yes
- Avoid using mulch or bark chippings around woody hedging like Privet or Griselinia, as it can sometimes cause fungal diseases.

PHOTINIA RED ROBIN

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Photinia Red Robin offers year-round interest with clusters of delicate white flowers in spring and vivid scarlet leaves that transition to striking deep green in winter. Although not overly dense, its evergreen nature and large leaves provide sufficient privacy. With an average growth rate, it can be easily maintained to a height of 4m, either in a formal hedge shape or left informal with occasional trims.

- Planting: Suitable for normal, clay or chalk soils, full sun to semi shade and inland or exposed sites
- Growth Rate: Average growth, up to 50cm per year
- Height: Easily maintained at 1-4m
- Maintenance: Trimmed once or twice a year
- Soil drainage:Moist but well drained
- Flowering - yes
- Berries - no

- Growth Rate: Very fast growing, expect up to 100cm per year
- Height: Easily maintained at 1-6m
- Maintenance: Trimmed once or twice a year
- Soil drainage:Moist but well drained
- Flowering - no
- Berries - no

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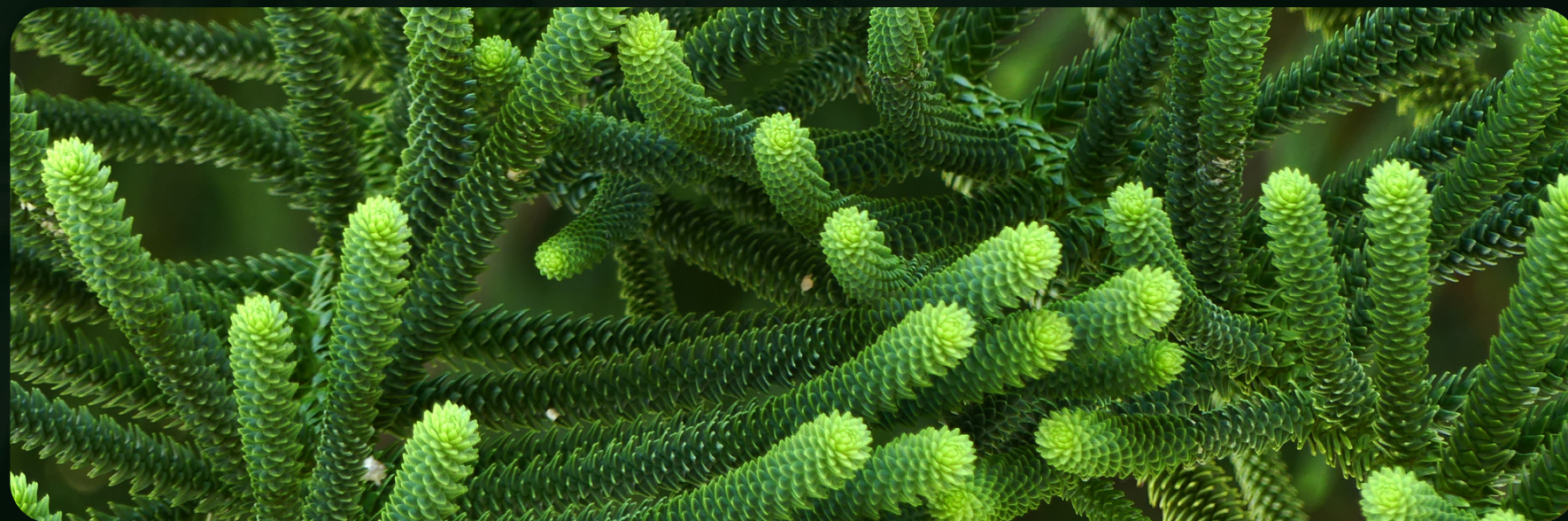
Euonymus Jap. ‘Green Spire’ – The Perfect Box Alternative
